# 53<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Dental Board of Australia – 20 June 2014

The Dental Board of Australia (the National Board) is established under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law, as in force in each state and territory (the National Law).

This communiqué highlights key discussions and considerations from the National Board's June 2014 meeting. The National Board was pleased to welcome the Chairs and/or representatives of the state and territory registration and notification committees who attended this meeting.

## **Register your interest in Scope of practice forums**

The National Board has released the revised <u>Scope of practice registration standard</u> and associated <u>Guidelines for Scope of practice</u>. To assist practitioners understand what they need to do to comply with the revised registration standard and associated guidelines, the National Board has released an <u>FAQ</u>. The revised registration standard and associated guidelines came into effect on **30 June 2014** and will replace the previous version of the registration standard.

### Consultation on registration standards and guidelines

This stage of consultation is open to everyone. We encourage all interested practitioners, members of the community and other stakeholders to have input. The consultation paper can be found on our website under the <u>News</u> tab. The consultation closes on 14 July 2014.

Dental practitioners must practise in a way that maintains and enhances public health and safety by ensuring that the risk of the spread of infectious diseases is prevented or minimised. Dental practitioners should read and understand the <u>Guidelines on infection control</u> which address how dental practitioners can prevent or minimise the risk of the spread of infectious diseases in the dental setting.
